Another highlight on the programme is Collaborative Roomsets, which will see creatives from about 15 interior design and architectural studios – some of whom are pictured above – collaborating in creating roomsets under the direction of Andrea Kleinloog and Megan Hesse, co-owners of Anatomy Design and HK Studio. “Visitors will

I see Joburg as based on industry and production, whereas Cape Town has a more craft-specific focus. I am looking forward to seeing the marriage of these two design cultures on a single platform.”

She also believes South African designers can hold their own on the global stage. “I don’t see combining local with international as a challenge.”
